as Wynonna Judd

Wynonna Judd was one of the artists who inspired Victoria to leave her hometown of Dixon, Illinois, and pursue a life in music in Nashville. She has shared the stage with Loretta Lynn, Joe Diffie, and Brenda Lee and has appeared as a solo artist on the Grand Ole Opry. Her song "Back to You" was recorded by Take 6 for their Grammy-nominated album *The Standard*, and her own recording "Pretty Lies" reached No. 1 on the European charts in 2025. She hosts and produces Dollywood's annual I Will Always Love You Songwriter Festival and will appear in the television series *The Running Father*.



Liz Byler Shea

as Naomi Judd

Liz began performing professionally in television, film, and music at a young age, appearing in national campaigns for Target and Toyota and singing "Blue Box Blues" for Kraft Macaroni & Cheese. Her film credits include *October Sky*, *Other Voices*, *Other Rooms*, and John Grisham's *A Painted House*. She has worked onstage with Lee Greenwood, toured with Martina McBride, and appeared as a solo performer on *Star Search*, where she received a near-perfect score from the judges, including Naomi Judd. Portraying Naomi brings Liz's career full circle, honoring a woman and performer whose voice she had listened to long before she ever imagined stepping into her shoes.

Fun fact: Victoria and Liz both performed at Opryland USA theme park, where they first met in the early '90s.

Backline	One professional acoustic guitar with pickup (Martin or Taylor type) · one combo amp (Fender preferred) · keyboard stand and bench
Lighting	Warm stage wash with front-of-house electric · lighting operator required
Schedule	Load-in 1 · load-out 1 · 2 hours before performance · 3-hour sound-check window
